Craft beer is usually all-malt, made in small batches by an independent microbrewery. It's made using traditional brewing methods and premium ingredients. Brew masters chose fresh ingredients carefully and there is a lot of time spent in the quality of the taste and inventing new flavours. Craft beer often tastes better than mass-produced corporate beer and tends to contain a higher alcohol content. This means more fun for you!

# Niagara Breweries

## Silversmith Brewing Co.

We are a brand new, one-of-a kind, small scale brewery located in Niagara-on-the-Lake. The location? A former church built around 1894, covered in ivy. The exterior has been left intact while the interior has been recently renovated with rustic exposed wooden beams and brick walls. Definitely something you have to see for yourself. When possible, we use local produced ingredients and support local farmers. Each batch we produce is fresh, unfiltered and unpasteurized with no extra ingredients or preservatives. We put a lot of time and care into our methods to ensure the beer you taste is extra tasty!

### **Bavarian Breakfast Wheat Beer / \$7.50 per glass**

- *Is brewed with a classic interpretation of the Weissbier style. It has a light-golden hazy appearance, tall, persistent head and aromas of clove & banana. It is presented in a curvaceous glass to accentuate the beer's unique characteristics. It is never served with orange or lemon slices.*

### **Black Lager / \$7.50 per glass**

- *Is brewed with a classic interpretation of the Schwarzbier style. It conforms to the Bavarian Beer Purity Standards of 1516 (only 4 ingredients). It has a very subtle malty aroma. It's remarkably light-bodied with mild, toasted malt flavours reminiscent of coffee & chocolate. It finishes like a classic lager; crisp, clean and dry. Its bold appearance and easygoing character put in a category all its own. Best served cold (4°C).*

### **Dam Buster English Pale Ale (Bitter ) / \$7.50 per glass**

- *Is a true English Bitter, however, the term "bitter" tends to discourage unfamiliar consumers, so we refer to it by its broader category title of English Pale Ale. It is clear, has a deep copper colour, it's lightly carbonated, with a slight head. It is beautifully balanced with slight hop bitterness and caramel sweetness with hints of fresh orange. It is served in a standard pub glass.*

### **Hill 145 Golden Ale / \$7.50 per glass**

- *Is a relatively low alcohol version of the style with bountiful tropical aromatics, there are hints of malt flavours, a subtle rye spiciness and remarkably dry finish. True to style, this beer is easy-drinking and very approachable. April 9, 2017 will mark the 100th anniversary of the Battle of Vimy ridge, with include the capture of 'Hill 145' by the WWI Canadian Forces. 'Hill145' Golden Ale is brewed as a celebration for the Canadian spirit and a node of gratitude to those Canadians who serve. Silversmith is proud to participate in the 2017 Vimy anniversary events.*

## Niagara College Brewery

The Niagara College Teaching Brewery is Canada's first and only teaching brewery and practical learning environment for students in Niagara College's Brewmaster/Brewery Operations Management program. Driven by the demand for skilled workers in Canada's burgeoning craft brewing industry, the brewery answers the need for a training system that addresses all aspects of brewery education to fill industry-specific positions with qualified people who have practical experience and specialist knowledge in beer production, brewery management and product sales/marketing. Wherever possible, the Niagara College Teaching Brewery uses local products, while encouraging local farmers to produce malt and hops, as well as other brew flavourings such as honey and fruit.

### **1827 Butler's Butter** / \$7.50 per glass

- *Flavours include medium bitterness with significant fruity esters. Hop flavours are characteristic of UK hop varieties described as earthy, resin and flowery. The hop bitterness gives a good balance, but does not overpower the caramel flavours of malt nor the fruity esters.*

### **First Draft Lager** / \$7.50 per glass

- *Slight malty sweetness, spicy, floral, and well balanced.*

### **First Draft Ale** / \$7.50 per glass

- *Strong flavours of caramel on tip of the tongue, rolling back into a citrusy finish with notes of tangerine, fresh herbs, lemon and mint.*
